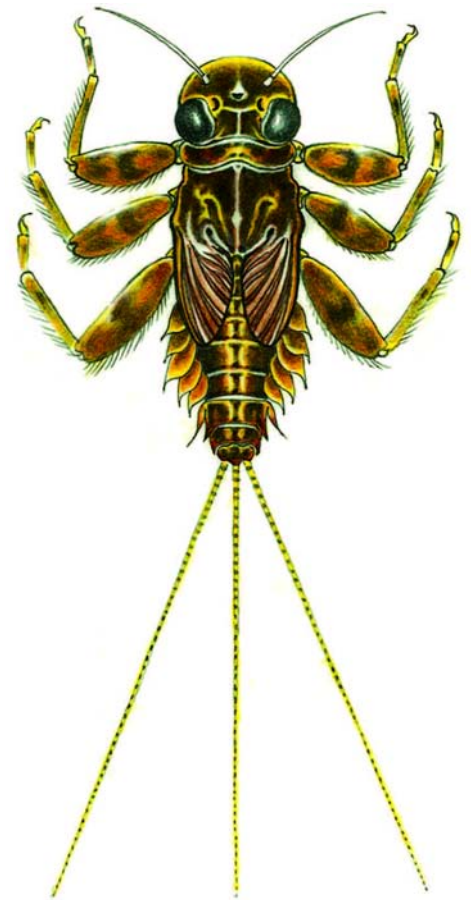




Book Signing with Erik Schwiebert Monday, July 2, 2007 11:00 A.M. – 2 P.M.

The American Museum of Fly Fishing is pleased to invite the public to a reception celebrating the newly released edition of the late Ernest Schwiebert's groundbreaking book, *Nymphs*. We are thrilled to have Ernest's son Erik Schwiebert on hand to sign these books. Ernest Schwiebert was a devoted trustee of the museum and one of the most important authors and figures in the sport of fly fishing in the 20th century.

Before he passed away in 2005, Ernest wrote and illustrated this new edition of his ground breaking book. The 1973 edition of *Nymphs* set forth his initial findings. Now in this wholly revised and expanded form, Schwiebert's last work offers the reader exacting details of every major mayfly species for the sake of identification, along with recipes for dozens of fly patterns to imitate them. This new edition also includes numerous stories and anecdotes from Schwiebert's travels, some never set down in writing before, that further add to the understanding of how to choose, cast, and fish nymphs.
